

START: At intersection of 81st & Oak Park, 25' 10" south of stop sign at NW corner, 26' N. of telephone pole at SW corner.

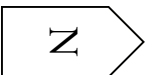
1 MILE: At sidewalk to 6145 - 81st and 6146 - 81st, 8' 9" E. of snow route sign

2 MILE: By school at middle of driveway, 6340 - 85th, 12' E. of telephone pole F 60.S.P.P.

3 MILE: At driveway 6740 - 81st, 12" east of the mailbox.

FINISH: At stop sign at S exit of Burbank Park District parking lot, 13' 4" W. of west edge at Newcastle.

1 MILE WALK: Will begin at the starting line, reach the half mile mark and end at the finish line.
