Vital News for Pool Users

- No outside food and beverages are allowed, and no food and beverages are allowed out of the concession area. Food and beverages are available for purchase at the pool concession stand.
- Strollers and buggies are considered hazardous and are not allowed on pool deck.
- 3. Only plain white t-shirts may be worn in the water.
- 4. Only swimsuits with liners are allowed in the pool. No cutoffs, basketball shorts, spandex, etc. Street shoes and street clothes may not be worn on the pool deck. A person accompanying a family member may wear prescribed religious attire (excluding shoes or other footwear worn outside of the pool) on the pool deck, but such persons must stay at least 3 feet away from the pool and must stay in the area of the pool deck adjacent to water which is not deeper than 5 feet.
- 5. Only Coast Guard approved life jackets with an underbody strap are allowed in the pool in water no deeper than the wearers chest. An adult 18 years or older must accompany all children wearing a life vest at arms length.
- 6. Personal locks left locked in pool locker rooms will be cut nightly. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Strict discipline will be enforced in all areas of the pool complex. Failure to comply with the rules may result in suspension or termination of privileges, with no refund.
- 8. During adult swim everyone under the age of 18 will be asked to clear the pool and stay at least 6 ft. from the water.
- 9. <u>You must be 42" or taller to go down the waterslides</u> and no eyeglasses are allowed down the waterslides.
- 10. No children over the age of 9 are allowed in the aquatic playground.
- 11. All children wearing diapers must wear rubber pants.
- 12. No masks, fins, toys or balls, etc. are allowed in any of the pools.
- 13. All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult, 18 and over, at arms length.
- 14. Pool regulations are established for everyone's safety. Additional rules may be added at any time for your protection.


Diving Lessons

Early Warning Lightning Detection Systems

The Park District has installed Early Warning Lightning Detection Systems at Michael Looney, Narragansett, Rice, Harr, Stevenson, MacArthur and Newcastle Parks. If lightning strikes the ground within a 5 mile radius, a horn will sound and a strobe light will flash. If this happens, you should seek shelter in a safe place. After 30 minutes of no ground lightning strikes, an all clear intermittent horn will sound and the strobe light will turn off.

Frequently Asked Questions: Why Does A Class Get Cancelled?

The Burbank Park District has long been known for offering some diverse programs. Classes and special events meet the varied interests, ages and skill levels of all our residents and those in nearby communities. However, classes sometimes have to be cancelled. There are many reasons why. The first and foremost reason is that a particular time offering does not reach its minimum enrollment requirement. Secondly, a new program of interest that was requested by a few patrons is set up, but does not catch on immediately. Also, an instructor may become ill or suddenly unavailable, or a facility may have an unavoidable schedule conflict. These factors we cannot control, especially if the facility is not owned by the park district. The important thing to remember is that no matter what the reason for the class cancellation, the park district staff will make every effort to accommodate you or a family member into a similar program. If we cannot do this, we will happily refund your money. So take a chance ---- try something new. Be adventurous. You have nothing to lose and only fun, friendship and new experiences to gain. 
